- **DECEMBER ACTIVITIES**

1) *Logo Contest*

2) *Self-Introduction*

Collaborative Activity:

New Year Exchange: Digital New Year cards are prepared. Turkish students write "Happy New Year" messages in Romanian, and Romanian students write in Turkish. (It can be in English as well but try to encourage sts to do them in Turkish and Romanian)

- **JANUARY ACTIVITIES**

1) *Greetings, Numbers, and Some Words (Each partner will decide which words they'll pick by talking to their own students.)*

Collaborative Game:

- Mixed Country Teams: After seeing the partner's materials, Mixed Country Teams are formed. A live Kahoot competition is held; Turkish students try to answer Romanian questions, and Romanian students try to answer Turkish questions.

- **FEBRUARY ACTIVITIES**

1) *Traditions, Cuisine, and Urban Legends*

Students from both countries prepare short videos or presentations introducing their cities, telling their own one of urban legends or one of their own meals using Web 2 Tools.

Common Product:

- Digital Magazine: An e-magazine is created (using Web 2 Tools). The left page features a Turkish recipe (in English), and the right page features a Romanian recipe. Students can try these recipes at home and share photos.
- **MARCH ACTIVITIES**

1) *Music, Art, and Famous People*

Song Exchange: Turkish students learn and sing a popular or traditional Romanian song (playback or karaoke), and Romanian students sing a Turkish song.

Collaborative Activity:

Virtual Museum: A virtual exhibition hall is established using a web 2 tool. Photos of artworks by famous painters or tourist spots from both cultures are hung on the walls. Mixed teams organize this museum together.

- **APRIL ACTIVITIES**

Common Final Product:

"The Traveler's Guide": A collaborative book containing words, foods, and places learned throughout the project. It will include sections like "*What should a Turk do if they visit Romania?*" and "*What should a Romanian do if they visit Turkey?*".
